9 WHEREAS, Sergeant Walter C. Gobin, as Structural Specialist from

10 Cornish, New Hampshire, was assigned as Non Commissioned Officer in

11 Charge, 36th Civil Engineer Squadron has shown deep compassion for the

12 people of Guam by his efforts in working with the Boy Scouts of America. He

ensured 21 boys enjoyed a memorable experience earning a scuba diving

14 merit badge and learning about Guam's un derwater world. He set up a

wireless, computerized accountability system helping the F.B. Leon Guerrero

- 1 Middle School establish a library with 5000 donated books and cleaned eight
- 2 viruses off of donated computers for the schools use, and
- 3 WHEREAS, Sergeant Gobin's support of local events includes Project
- 4 AWARE's International Cleanup Day, participating in three of Guam's
- 5 costal cleanups removing over 4.5 tons of debris from the reefs. He
- 6 participated in an international mooring instillation project. He assisted with
- 7 the instillation of five boat moorings, saving Guam's reefs from damage done
- 8 by dive boats dropping anchors on the reefs.
- 9 WHEREAS, Sergeant Gobin was a champion of support to Team
- 10 Andersen's comm unity relations; he led the setup and preparation of a
- secure site for Vise President Dick Cheney's visit to G uam, working directly
- 12 with Secret Service and White House staff to set up a stage, barriers, press
- 13 box, and passageway for the event. He packed 70 pallets with new clothing,
- shoes, fishing gear, snorkeling equipment, and food items for the 54th annual
- 15 humanitarian Christmas Drop. His efforts ensured over 21 tons of much
- 16 needed supplies were delivered to 59 remote Micronesian islands. He
- 17 represented the 36th Civil Engineer Squadron as the point of contact in the
- setup for Tops in Blue three years in a row. He planned and executed the

- 1 setup of the stage and seating areas for the community relations bolstering
- 2 event. His efforts set the pace for a great performance for 3000 visitors.
- 3 Additionally, Sergeant Gobin was instrumental during the Air Force
- 4 Thunderbirds 2004 visit to Guam. He set up security fencing and volunteered
- 5 to represent Andersen during the weekend event, patrolling the grounds to
- 6 help visitors who needed assistance. He also led the annual CES haunted
- 7 house, raising over 3K over a three year period for Christmas celebrations.
- 8 WHEREAS, Sergeant Gobin was a key player in his squadron's receipt
- 9 of the Pacific Air Forces' Outst anding Civil Engineer Unit, small unit
- 10 category and one of the three finalists for the 2005 award Air Force wide. In
