BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I

WHEREAS, Supervisory Senior Resident Agent Kevin E. Rickett
possesses a vast store of experience in law enforcement having served as
Sergeant with the Blackford County Sheriff's Department in Indiana Deputy
Prosecutor in Pulaski County in Indiana; and

WHEREAS, Supervisory Senior Resident Agent Kevin E. Rickett
completed his Federal Bureau of Investigation training at Quantico, Virginia
in June of 1991 to begin an outstanding career in Federal Law Enforcement
wherein he has been involved in a variety of investigations, and served as the
Firearms Instructor, Tactical Instructor, SWAT Team member, the

1 Administrator of the Multi-Agency Fugitive Task Force, which was
2 responsible for the arrest of over 1,200 fugitives, and was assigned to Special
3 Detail Unit working under two former Attorneys General; and

5 to Guam in April of 2003 and has had an outstanding assignment on Guam,
6 having been in charge of the FBI's offices in Guam and Saipan and working

8 the Federated States of Micronesia and has given unselfishly in promoting
9 cooperation between the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the people of
10 Guam, where his presence will surely be missed by friends in the civilian and
11 law-enforcement community; and

12 **WHEREAS**, SSRA Kevin E. Rickett is leaving the island of Guam to
13 begin his next assignment and will be joined by his wife, Julie Rickett and
14 their two children; now, therefore, be it
