- 3 WHEREAS, Roger VanDyke, MAJ, AN, USAR was born on March 3,
- 4 1958 and currently resides in Atlanta, Georgia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Major VanDyke received his Bachelors degree in Nursing
- 6 from Niagara University, Niagara County, New York in 1989; and
- WHEREAS, Major VanDyke received his diploma in Paralegal
- 8 Studies/Legal Nursing Consulting in 2001 from the College of Professional Studies
- 9 in Boca Raton, Florida; and

1	WHEREAS, Major VanDyke, from 1982 to 1988, was a Mental Hygiene
2	Therapy Assistant/Community Resident Assistant Director, at the Office of Mental
3	Retardation and Developmental Disabilities in Syracuse, New York; and
4	WHEREAS, Major VanDyke, from 1989 to 1990 was a Staff Critical Care
5	Nurse at the Crouse-Irving Memorial Hospital in Syracuse, New York; and
6	WHEREAS, Major VanDyke, from 1990 to 2000 was on active duty with
7	the United States Public Health Service / Indian Health Service stationed in
8	Anchorage, Alaska at the Alaska Native Medical Center where he was Associate
9	Chief (Assistant Nurse Manager) Internal Medicine Unit from 1987 to 2000, and
10	Senior Staff Nurse Intensive Care Unit from 1992 to 1997; and
11	WHEREAS, Major VanDyke was reactivated by the United States Public
12	Health Service in early 2002 to a limited tour of duty to assist staffing crisis at
13	Alaska Native Medical Center in Anchorage, Alaska, and again later that year on a
14	limited tour of duty and attachment to the United States Army to assist with
15	staffing and provide expertise as a process consultant at Fort Gordon in Augusta,
16	Georgia; and
17	WHEREAS, Major VanDyke in 2003 was appointed to the United States
18	Army Reserves and was assigned to the 3297th United States Army Hosptial,
19	Atlanta Unit W8KX02 and served as the Assistant Officer in Charge (AOIC) of the
20	OER section; and
21	WHEREAS, Major VanDyke, from 2004 to 2006, went on active duty and
22	was assigned to the Brooke Army Medical Center (BAMC), Fort Sam Houston,
23	Texas in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. From November 2004 to June
24	2006 he was attached to the Institute for Surgical Research Acute Burn Care Unit,
25	from June 2006 to November 2006 he served as member of the BAMC command
26	structure in the position of Nursing Supervisor; and,

1	WHEREAS, Major VanDyke, in November 2006, returned to reserve status
2	and has been assigned to the 3297th United States Army Hospital, Atlanta Unit S-1;
3	and
4	WHEREAS, the information shared by Major VanDyke with the people of
5	Guam will be very important in our continuing efforts to control diabetes on
6	Guam; and
7	WHEREAS, as much as twenty-five (25) percent of Guam's population has
8	contracted type 2 diabetes, an incurable metabolic disease caused by poor diet and
9	a sedentary lifestyle that can lead to blindness, kidney damage, nerve damage, poor
10	circulation, limb amputations and heart disease; and
11	WHEREAS, an estimated sixty (60) percent of Chamorros, or more than
12	20,000 Chamorros on Guam, have type 2 diabetes or the pre-diabetic condition
13	known as impaired glucose tolerance; and
14	WHEREAS, Major VanDyke's experience numerous aspects of nursing
15	practice, nursing management and policy development will be very helpful in the
16	battle against diabetes in our community; and
17	WHEREAS, Guam is proud and honored to invite Major Roger VanDyke to
18	be a Guest Speaker at the Eight Annual Guam Diabetes Association Conference to
19	share his expertise in the prevention and control of diabetes; now, therefore, be it
20	RESOLVED, that I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan does
21	hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, commend and congratulate Major Roger
22	VanDyke for his contribution to educating the community on the prevention and
23	control of Diabetes and to welcome him to Guam as a Guest Speaker for the Eight
