


**Relative to memorializing the accomplishments of the late
Hazime Techemang Telei, Director of the Bureau of Public
Safety of the Republic of Palau, and offering condolences to
his family.**

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN**
2 **GUÅHAN:**

3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Hazime Techemang Telei was commissioned in 1982 as a Police
4 Officer I under the Bureau of Public Safety, Palau; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei personified professionalism and integrity in public
6 safety as a Police Officer I and was honorably promoted to Police Officer II in 1982; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei continuously exemplified public safety adeptness and
8 was elected as Vice President of the Board of Directors of the Palau Community Action
9 Agency (PCAA) in 1989, which he served as until his death; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei was promoted to the rank of Police Sergeant, Bureau
11 of Public Safety in 1991; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei was assigned as the Commander of a Special Task
2 Force within the Bureau of Public Safety in 1993; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei was assigned as the Crime Stoppers Coordinator and
4 Public Information Officer for the Bureau of Public Safety in 1994; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei, ascended to the position of Acting Chief, Division of
6 Corrections in 1995; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei was appointed as the Coordinator of the National
8 Emergency Management Office, under the Office of the Vice President of the Republic
9 of Palau in 1997; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei was appointed as Director of the Bureau of Public
11 Safety, Republic of Palau on September 28th, 2003 and remained there until his death;
12 and

13 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei was instrumental in the development and initiation of
14 the Micronesian Police Executives Association (MPEA) of which he served as Chairman
15 of the 4th Micronesian Police Executives Association (MPEA) from July 2006 to August
16 2007; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei initiated a resolution at the 34th South Pacific Chiefs
18 of Police (SPCP) Conference in Tonga, which proposed the change of name of the South
19 Pacific Chiefs of Police (SPCP) to the Pacific Islands Chiefs of Police (PICP) to unite in
20 name all members of the organization, and served as Chairman of the Pacific Islands
21 Chiefs of Police (PICP) from July 2006 to October 2007; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Director Telei through his dedicated service, innovation,
23 commitment, and professionalism, profoundly influenced, shaped and molded the
24 Republic of Palau's Bureau of Public Safety into the organization that it is today; and
25 now, therefore, be it

26 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on
27 behalf of the people of Guam, extend heartfelt condolences to the family of Mr. Hazime

1 Techemang Telei for their loss, and laud and honor Director Hazime Techemang Telei
2 for his twenty five (25) years of service to the people of Palau and expresses sincere
3 gratitude for his contributions towards the enhancement of the Law Enforcement network
4 between Guam, Palau, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, the CNMI, the FSM, and
5 other agencies within the Pacific region; and be it further

6 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Secretary of the Legislature attest
7 to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to the
8 Honorable Tommy E. Remengesau, Jr., President of the Republic of Palau, the Honorable

10 Note, President of the Republic of the Marshall Islands, the Honorable Benigno Fitial,
11 Governor of the Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas Islands, the Honorable Felix
12 P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*, and Congresswoman Madeleine Z. Bordallo.
