RELATIVE TO COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING SCHOLAR-ATHELETE AND NATIVE OF GUAM, MS. JESSICA MICHELLE LUJAN ON HER RECRUITMENT AND COMMITMENT TO SEATTLE UNIVERSITY IN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON TO FULFILL HER UNDGRADUATE STUDIES WITH THE HOPES OF PURSING A CAREER IN SPECIAL EDUCATION.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA' BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:

2 WHEREAS, Ms. Jessica Michelle Lujan was born on March 22, 1990 in San Diego,
3 California to her father, Senator Jesse Anderson Lujan and her mother, Christina Dresslar.
4 Jessica currently resides in Murrieta, California with her mom, step-father, Robert Dresslar, and
5 older sister, Cherise Baggay, who is in her Junior Year at Mount San Jacinto College in Menifee,
6 California where she is majoring in Nursing, with a specialization in Pediatrics. Jessica also has
7 an older brother, Ryan Guy, who presently resides in Ireland playing professional futbol
8 (soccer) for the St. Patrick's Athletics Team o f the Irish Futbol League; and

9 WHEREAS, at the early age of five (5) years old, Jessica started playing softball. After
10 only one (1) year of playing, she was selected to play in the Eight-and-Under Division. For the
11 next several years, she continued playing recreational softball for the City of Murrieta's Valley
12 Girls Softball Association (MVGSA); and

13 WHEREAS, after completing her first (1st) year of play for the Ten-and-Under Division,
14 she made the cuts for the Travel Ball Team, "Southern California Filly' s." She has continued
15 to play Travel Ball since then; and

16 WHEREAS, Jessica has excelled as a fastpitch softball player which has allowed her to
17 travel across the United States to play in different tournaments including several held in New
18 Jersey, Nebraska, Southern and Northern California, Nevada, Oregon, Arizona, and Oklahoma

1 City, just to name a few. At the same time she was developing her career as a fastpitch softball
2 player, traveling allowed Jessica to learn from the experience of being exposed to other cultures,
3 and being able to share the hardly known Chamorro culture that is her own; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Jessica currently attends Vista Murrieta High School, where she will
5 graduate in June of 2008. In her academic career, Jessica has maintained an Honor Student
6 status and has received the "Scholar Athlete" award each year from her Freshman through her
7 Junior Year of high school. In her athletic career, Jessica has played for the Girls Varsity
8 Fastpitch Softball Team all four years of high school, serving as the Captain of her team during
9 her Junior and Senior Years. Jessica has been rewarded for her success as both a student and an
10 athlete through receivership of a scholarship, based on sports and merit, to attend Seattle
11 University, where she has been recruited to play Second-Base; and now, therefore, be it
