



**Relative to offering condolences to the family of the late Charles Henri Parent, M.D. who dedicated his life and profession to the people of Guam.**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I**  
2 ***MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS**, Charles Henri Parent was born on March 28, 1921 in Levis City,  
4 Quebec, Canada to Alice Guay Parent and Ernest Parent, passed away on November  
5 6, 2007. He will be remembered in the hearts of his brothers and sisters Francine St.  
6 Hillare, Mariette Cloutier, Andre Parent, Laurent Parent, Lorraine Parent who reside  
7 in Quebec, Canada, his reared and extended families and close and special families at  
8 the Department of Public Health and Social Services; and

1           **WHEREAS**, “*Dr. P*” as he was affectionately called, came to Guam in 1976  
2 after Typhoon Pamela ravaged the island to work for FHP Guam; and

3           **WHEREAS**, “*Dr. P*” started working at the Department of Public Health and  
4 Social Services Southern Regional Health Clinic in August 1978 providing medical  
5 clinic services to the southern area residents and in December 22, 1981 became  
6 Medical Director of the Department’s Home Care Program, Hypertension Control  
7 Program, and *Salud Y Manamko* Program. In May 1985, “*Dr. P*” provided additional  
8 medical services to the Communicable Disease Control Clinic and Immigration Clinic  
9 and in 1995 served as the Medical Advisor for Communicable Disease Control  
10 Program; and

11           **WHEREAS**, during his tenure at the Department of Public Health and Social  
12 Services, “*Dr. P*” has been characterized by PeterJohn Camacho as such: “Dr. Parent  
13 is always accessible to staff and pitches in when needed to care for other physician’s  
14 patients.” and

15           **WHEREAS**, having served the Department of Public Health and Social  
16 Services for 29 years, “*Dr. P*” was a member on the following organizations: Fellow  
17 International College of Surgeons; American Medical Association; American Board  
18 of Surgery; American Society of Abdominal Surgeons; Florida Medical Association;  
19 Florida Association of Industrial and R.R. Surgrons; Broward County Medical  
20 Association; Canadian Medical Association; Guam Medical Association; GMH  
21 Courtesy Staff Member; Southern Medical Association; Pan-Pacific Surgical  
22 Association; Red Cross Advanced Life Support Certified; Fellow American Society of  
23 Contemporary Medicine and Surgery; and

24           **WHEREAS**, Dr. Parent can best be described as a “very humble and simple  
25 man”, his favorite phrase was “*Life is Ephemeral ... Nothing Lasts forever*” and was  
26 very generous to regularly donated to the Catholic Social Services, the Red Cross, the

1 University of Guam and other educational institutions; and at the same time fully  
2 funding educational expenses for deserving students; now, therefore, be it

3 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na*  
4 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people  
5 of Guam, offer its condolences to the family of Dr. Charles Henri Parent on the  
6 passing of a true medical professional; and be it further

7 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na*  
8 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people  
9 of Guam, express its appreciation for the many contributions made by Dr. Charles  
10 Henri Parent towards public health care; and be it further

11 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Executive Committee  
12 certify, and the Secretary of the Legislature attest to, the adoption hereof, and that  
13 copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to the Family of Dr. Charles Henri Parent;  
14 to the Honorable Madeleine Z. Bordallo, Guam's Delegate to the United States  
15 Congress; and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*.
