WHEREAS, Joseph Leon Guerrero Manibusan, born on Guam on New Year's Day in 1946 to Jose and Antonia Manibusan and raised in the village of Asan, Guam, has dedicated his life, not only to being an exemplary employee with the Federal Government, but a devoted husband to Julia, father to Joseph, Roland, Franklin, Anthony, Joleen and Julie and grandfather to 14 grandchildren as well; and

WHEREAS, Joseph Manibusan, upon starting employment with the Federal Government, eventually detailed to the Air Mobility Command at Andersen Air Force Base, Guam, for over 4 decades, has exemplified stability, commitment, loyalty and longevity as a model employee at his work site, receiving unprecedented recognition and numerous awards for outstanding service for the greater part of his career including several letters of

- WHEREAS, in addition to his dedication on the job, Joe has also

- 7 Vietnam War, the Kosovo evacuation and the Kurdish Safe Haven Operation,
- 8 as well as disasters locally including Typhoons Pamela in 1976, Omar in 1992,
- 9 Paka in 1997 and Pongsona in 2001; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Joe's guidance, leadership, enthusiasm, professionalism and
- 11 vigor will be greatly missed by his superiors and subordinates alike as he
- 12 retires after 42 distinguished years of service; now, therefore, be it
