Relative to Recognizing and Congratulating Mr. Joseph L.G. Manibusan for his 42 years of employment with the Air Mobility Squadron at Andersen Air Force Base, Guam as he retires as a dedicated and decorated civil servant

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I  
2 *MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:*

3 WHEREAS, Joseph Leon Guerrero Manibusan, born on Guam on New  
4 Year's Day in 1946 to Jose and Antonia Manibusan and raised in the village of  
5 Asan, Guam, has dedicated his life, not only to being an exemplary employee  
6 with the Federal Government, but a devoted husband to Julia, father to  
7 Joseph, Roland, Franklin, Anthony, Joleen and Julie and grandfather to 14  
8 grandchildren as well; and

9 WHEREAS, Joseph Manibusan, upon starting employment with the  
10 Federal Government, eventually detailed to the Air Mobility Command at  
11 Andersen Air Force Base, Guam, for over 4 decades, has exemplified stability,  
12 commitment, loyalty and longevity as a model employee at his work site,  
13 receiving unprecedented recognition and numerous awards for outstanding  
14 service for the greater part of his career including several letters of

1 commendation and Superior and Outstanding Performance and Special  
2 Achievement awards 20 times; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in addition to his dedication on the job, Joe has also  
4 tirelessly volunteered his time to his community and went beyond the call of  
5 duty by taking on major challenges on the job that included assisting with  
6 international events such as the relocation of Vietnamese refugees during the  
7 Vietnam War, the Kosovo evacuation and the Kurdish Safe Haven Operation,  
8 as well as disasters locally including Typhoons Pamela in 1976, Omar in 1992,  
9 Paka in 1997 and Pongsona in 2001; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Joe's guidance, leadership, enthusiasm, professionalism and  
11 vigor will be greatly missed by his superiors and subordinates alike as he  
12 retires after 42 distinguished years of service; now, therefore, be it

14 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the  
15 people of Guam, recognize and congratulate Mr. Joseph Leon Guerrero
