WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Fitzgerald, a Civil Engineer from California who was assigned as Chief, Facility Repair who developed and initiated the engineering plan; and

WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Fitzgerald continued to strengthen the unique partnership with the 254th Civil Engineer Squadron, Guam Air National Guard. He acquired over five thousand (5,000) Air National Guard man-days from the Headquarters Pacific Air Forces providing employment for more than thirty (30) Air National Guard members within the 36th Civil Engineering Squadron. He continued to partner with the Guam Air National Guard, developing a full-time work sharing relationship by providing the 254th Civil Engineers with real-world projects for their weekend duties. This provided the opportunity for the Guam Air National Guard civil engineers to complete their engineering skills training while completing work orders that support the Andersen community; and

WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Fitzgerald is a staunch supporter of base appearance. Through his leadership, the 36th Civil Engineer Squadron maintained its in-house Grounds Maintenance Team of twenty (28) civilian employees, which has consistently maintained Andersen's grounds in pristine condition, making all who come to the island of Guam via Andersen AFB revel in its natural beauty. He supported the development of "pocket forests" throughout Andersen allowing several areas on base to become jungle once

again, giving Guam's wildlife a habitat. He led the Wing Top 3 in planting

WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Fitzgerald stewardship to the base and the island of Guam has been noteworthy to all who come in contact with him. He has proven his commitment to be steadfast during countless events on and off base as a Chief, Facility Repair for the 36th Civil Engineer Squadron. He has mentored eighteen (18) teenagers at the Yigo Activity Center where he promoted a positive image for the youth to follow. He volunteered and participated in the 61st, 62nd & 63d Guam Liberation Day Parade enhancing community relations with the community outside the gate; and

WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Fitzgerald's humanitarian efforts were always evident by his actions. His time and energy were extraordinary in recruiting the Andersen base populace to help with the success of the 2005, 2006 and 2007 Guam Special Olympics. He also mentored First Term Airman Center students by teaching ten (10) Professional Development courses to two hundred (220) new Team Andersen Warriors; and

WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Fitzgerald was a champion of support to Team Andersen's quality of life, he directed the support for the major holiday festivities on Andersen including the Winter Wonderland Parade, the Rota

Walk Holiday Lights Festival and the annual Tops and Blue performance. His work force constructed stages and provided utility and participant support, improving base and community quality of life. He led the way in improving the quality of life for Andersen personnel; he led thirty (30) volunteers at the Agana Heights Elementary school in maintaining their air conditioning system, saving the Government of Guam twelve-thousand dollars in maintenance costs. This provided the students a comfortable learning environment; and

WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Fitzgerald is truly an "Outstanding" volunteer, a key player of Team Andersen and the local community. He consistently and regularly volunteered whenever and wherever there is a need for his support and gives it his all to get the job done. He is positive influence to others around him and rallies member support (civilians and military personnel) from Andersen's community to volunteer and support in numerous events and fund raisers that benefit organizations on and off base. His Civil Engineering Squadron garnished the 2004, 2005 & 2006 PACAF Outstanding Small Unit Award three years running.
