- 9 WHEREAS, quality child care promotes the well-being of children and
- 10 responds to the needs of parents and the broader community by supporting

- 1 quality of life so that citizens can fully participate in and contribute to the
- 2 economic and social life of their island community; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Guam Child Caregiver Appreciation Week is being
- 4 celebrated this year from April 13 to April 19 to coincide with the National
- 5 Association for the Education of Young Children's (NAEYC), annual "WEEK
- 6 OF THE YOUNG CHILD" celebration; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Guam Child Caregiver Appreciation Week is a time set
- 8 aside to educate the public, and parents in particular, about the competent
- 9 adults who provide a safe, healthy, enriched programs for the children who
- 10 will become the citizens of tomorrow; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Guam Child Caregiver Appreciation Week is time
- 12 dedicated to our island community to celebrate the commitment of
- 13 professional child caregivers, individuals who have made the important
