Relative to recognizing the month of April 2008 as "Sexual Assault Awareness Month" to honoring sexual assault victims and to commending the employees of Government agencies and volunteers of private organizations for providing services and care to sexual assault victims.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I MINA'BENTE Ñ UEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÂHAN:

WHEREAS, our island recognizes and addresses the presence of sexual assault in our community to ensure that victims of this crime will no longer suffer pain and loss; and

WHEREAS, victims and survivors of sexual assault deserve assistance to help cope with the consequences of assault; and

WHEREAS, our island understands the importance of providing services and support programs to sexual assault victims and survivors need restoring their life through counseling, medical services, food and transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Sexual Assault Coalition, under the leadership of Healing Hearts Crisis Center of the Department of Mental Health and

- 1 Substance Abuse, has established partnerships between service organizations
- 2 and Government agencies to improve the quality of care for persons hurt by
- 3 sexual violence; and
- 4 **WHEREAS**, the Healing Hearts Crisis Center has provided services such
- 5 as a 24-hour hotline for emergency calls, social work and counseling services,
- 6 comforting victims during medico-legal rape exams, and empowering victims
- 7 to begin healing; and
- 8 **WHEREAS**, Government agencies and private organizations encourage
- 9 victims and survivors through education, prevention, survivor empowerment,
- and providing information to schools, churches, civic organizations, as well as
- 11 law enforcement, medical, mental health, education, and criminal justice
- 12 professionals; and
- 13 WHEREAS, our island community is encouraged to increase its
- 14 awareness and participation in an effort to rid our people of the tragedy of
- 15 sexual violence, to strengthen the community and to provide a safer
- 16 environment; and
- 17 **WHEREAS**, Guam joins the Nation in recognizing the month of April
- 18 2008 as 'Sexual Assault Awareness Month'; now, therefore, be it
- 19 **RESOLVED,** that the Executive Committee of I Mina' Bente Nuebi Na
- 20 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the
- 21 people of Guam, honor sexual assault victims and survivors for surpassing
- the obstacles and rebuilding their lives; and be it further
- 23 **RESOLVED,** that *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does
- 24 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, further commends the employees of

Government agencies and volunteers of private organizations who provide 1 2 services and care for sexual assault victims and survivors; and be it further RESOLVED, that I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan does 3 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, commend the employees and 4 volunteers of the Healing Hearts Crisis Center of the Department of Mental 5 6 Health and Substance Abuse and the Sexual Assault Coalition for educating the community about sexual assault and supporting sexual assault victims 8 and survivors; and be it further 9 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Executive 10 Committee certify, and the Secretary of the Legislature attest to, the adoption 11 hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to the Healing Hearts Crisis Center of the Department of Mental Health and Substance 12 13 Abuse; to the Department of Law; and to the Honorable Felix P.
