Relative to recognizing and congratulating the Simon Sanchez High School Lodging Management Program Class on their Overall 2nd Place showing at the American Hotel & Lodging Educational Institute National Lodging Management Program Competition held April 9-11, 2008 in Orlando Florida.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I MINA 'BENTE' NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, the American Hotel & Lodging Educational Institute National Lodging Management Program (LMP) Competition was held on April 9-11, 2008 at the Shades of Green Resort on the property of the Walt Disney World Resort in Orlando, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the competition is meant to expose and challenge students to the real-life work experiences they would face in a hotel; and

WHEREAS, the competition is put on by the Educational Institute, using funding provided by the American Hotel & Lodging Educational Foundation and tasked teams of students to display their proficiency while competing in three contests: Hotel Operations, The Hospitality Project, and The Knowledge Bowl; and

WHEREAS, LMP is a national educational program for high school juniors and seniors that covers topics in the program including lodging management, front office and housekeeping management, leadership skills, marketing and sales, and food and beverage service;

WHEREAS, the Guam Community College established its Lodging Management Program in 1997 and has conducted the program in each of Guam's public high schools, hosting its own local competition to decide the Guam representative to the national LMP competition held annually in Orlando, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Guam representative for 2008 was the team from Simon Sanchez High School comprised of members Rosewin Marasigan, Sherry Gozum, Lerio Abinales, and Persha Amparo, under the guidance of Instructor Norman Aguilar; and

WHEREAS, in all, 13 teams competed, representing schools in Arkansas, Florida, New
Hampshire, New York, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Texas, Arizona, Hawaii, Ohio
and Washington, D.C., as well as from Guam; and

WHEREAS, the Simon Sanchez High School team is the 1st group from Guam to place in the top three at the National Lodging Management Competition, including placing 2^{nd} in the Overall Competition, taking 2^{nd} Place in the Knowledge Bowl, and earning 2^{nd} Place in the Hospitality Project.; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina 'Bente Nuebi na Liheslaturan Guåhan*, on behalf of the people of Guam, does hereby recognize the Simon Sanchez High School LMP team as the first team representing our island to place in the top three of the American Hotel & Lodging Educational Institute National Lodging Management Program Competition; and, be it further
