BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

- WHEREAS, the great spirit of service is alive and well in AmeriCorps members and programs; and,
- WHEREAS, Guam's dedicated AmeriCorps members of all ages are a great treasure; and
- 7 WHEREAS, AmeriCorps could be described as the "domestic Peace
- 8 Corps" following in the same tradition of as the Peace Corps established by
- 9 President John F. Kennedy; and
- 10 **WHEREAS**, since inception of AmeriCorps in 1994 as a national service
- 11 program, it has proven to be a highly effective way to engage Americans of all

ages and backgrounds in meeting a wide range of local and national needs 1 2 and promoting the ethic of service and volunteerism; and 3 WHEREAS, AmeriCorps is the embodiment of the spirit of 4 volunteerism and service to our country, they tackle the toughest problems in 5 our communities – tutoring teens, starting neighborhood crime watches, 6 turning vacant lots into neighborhoods, and helping communities clean up 7 and rebuild after natural disasters, providing literacy and work readiness 8 skills, caring for the elderly and more. These contributions are essential to the 9 island's economic and social well-being. AmeriCorps volunteers are 10 unflagging, unflinching and determined to make a difference; and 11 WHEREAS, on August 30, 2004, the National Director of AmeriCorps 12 encouraged Guam to establish a Commission on National and Community 13 Service as Guam's vehicle to apply for and manage national service programs, 14 to include AmeriCorps programs; and WHEREAS, I Maga' låhen Guåhan established a Commission on National 15 16 and Community Service, referred to and known as the "Serve Guam! 17 Commission", through Executive Order 2005-22 on June 2, 2005 and, on June 30, 2005, I Maga' låhen Guåhan appointed fourteen (14) commissioners; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the Serve Guam! Commission is dedicated to helping to 20 improve the lives of our island's most vulnerable citizens, protect our 21 environment, contribute to our public safety, respond to disasters, and 22 strengthen our educational system; and

1 WHEREAS, the Commission's goals are to encourage Guam 's strong 2 sense of civic responsibility and rich tradition of community involvement; and 3 WHEREAS, the AmeriCorps program, working closely with its Nationwide network of Governor-appointed state service commissions, has 4 5 strengthened America's nonprofit sector community nonprofit groups, in 6 every community in our Nation; and 7 WHEREAS, each year, AmeriCorps provides opportunities for 8 thousands of Americans to dedicate a year of intensive service with nonprofit 9 and community organizations, and 10 WHEREAS, in Guam alone, more than 470 men and women have taken the AmeriCorps pledge to "get things done for America" actively building 11 12 culture of citizenship, service, and responsibility by becoming AmeriCorps 13 members since June 2007; and 14 WHEREAS, those AmeriCorps members have served a total of more 285,000 hours of service to the people of Guam through Serve Guam! 15 16 Commission; and 17 **WHEREAS**, AmeriCorps members nationwide, in return for their service, have earned more than \$1.4 billion in Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards to 18 19 use to further their own educational advancement at colleges and universitiesincluding more than \$4 million of these Education Awards that has been 20 21 awarded to residents of Guam; and

1 WHEREAS, many AmeriCorps alums remain engaged in their 2 communities even after their service, either working as teachers, non-profit 3 leaders or public servants; now, therefore, be it 4 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of I Mina' Bente Nuebi Na 5 Liheslaturan Guahan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guahan and the 6 people of Guam, designate May 11 to 18, 2008 as AmeriCorps Week and 7 salute the AmeriCorps volunteers and alums for their dedication and positive 8 impact to their communities and their inspiring examples of service as a great 9 motivation for all of us to give back to our island and to everyone in need; and 10 be it further 11 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Executive 12 Committee certify, and the Secretary of the Legislature attest to, the adoption 13 hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Pete Terlaje, 14 Department of Agriculture; to Arleen Tedtaotao, Department of Youth Affairs; 15 Bobbie Roberto, Micronesian Business Association; to Claudia Taitano, University of Guam; to Pat Wolff, Inafa' Maolek and to the Honorable Felix P. 16 17 Camacho, I Maga' lahen Guahan. 18 19 20 21 22 23
