WHEREAS, Petty Officer 2nd Class Anthony "Tony" Mark Fejeran Carbullido, of Agat, is the son of Mr. Anthony J. and Mrs. Aurora F. Carbullido. He was born on August 25, 1982 and is the brother of Austin and Ashley Carbullido; and

WHEREAS, Petty Officer 2nd Class Anthony "Tony" Mark Fejeran Carbullido was a member of the Southern High School cross-country team and *Korun Minagof* and graduated with the school's Class of 2000. Petty Officer 2nd Class Anthony "Tony" Mark Fejeran Carbullido was a member of the Twenty-First (21st) Guam Youth Congress and was elected Vice

Speaker in the Twenty-Second (22nd) Guam Youth Congress. He served as an Altar Server at his village parish, Our Lady of Mount Carmel and enjoyed running, fishing, diving, and other outdoor sports; and

WHEREAS, Petty Officer 2nd Class Anthony “Tony” Mark Fejeran Carbullido chose to follow the footsteps of his father at age eighteen (18) and joined the United States Armed Forces by enlisting in another branch, the U.S. Navy, in the fall of 2000. Following basic training at Great Lakes, Illinois, he was stationed at the Naval Medical Center in San Diego, California; and

WHEREAS, on September 26, 2007, Petty Officer 2nd Class Anthony “Tony” Mark Fejeran Carbullido married Summer Chaney and are blessed with a daughter Lexie; Summer is the daughter of Mr. Edward Leo Chaney and Mrs. Debbie Oliver, and granddaughter of Mrs. Elizabeth Ann Walters; and

WHEREAS, Petty Officer 2nd Class Anthony “Tony” Mark Fejeran Carbullido proved to be an excellent soldier and ascended the ranks to his recent designation of Petty Officer 2nd Class and was recently assigned to the Naval Hospital Corps School in Great Lakes, Illinois as an instructor; and
