- WHEREAS, Dr. Richard Regan Matheny is originally from the state of Tennessee and has made Guam his home since 1985; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Dr. Matheny was graduated from Eastern Kentucky
- 6 University in June of 1969 with a Bachelors of Arts Degree in Political Science
- 7 and History; he earned his Masters in Public Administration from Western
- 8 Kentucky University in 1970, a Masters in Political Science from Vanderbilt
- 9 University in 1975 and his Ph.D. from Vanderbilt University in 1980; and
- 10 **WHEREAS** before beginning his career at the University of Guam, Dr.
- 11 Matheny's work experience included serving as the Administrator for the
- 12 State of Tennessee Vocational Rehabilitation Office from 1970-1972, Vice
- 13 President and Director of Personnel at Styles Unlimited from 1978-1979,
- 14 Director of Research at Social Science Research Unlimited from 1972-1980,

- 1 Energy Data Base Manager at Tennessee Energy Authority from 1980-1983,
- 2 and as Vice President of Microdatabase Systems from 1983-1985; and
- 3 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Matheny has worked as a Teaching Assistant at
- 4 Western Kentucky University and Vanderbilt University and served as
- 5 Assistant Professor at various institutions including Fisk University,
- 6 University of Tennessee at Nashville, and Tennessee State University; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Matheny became a professor at the University of Guam
- 8 in 1985 where he taught such courses as Public Administration: Theory and
- 9 Method, Organizational Theory, and Public Policy Analysis; American
- 10 Government and Politics: Foreign Policy, Presidential Politics, and Public
- 11 Opinion; and International Relations: Theory and Method, Law and
- 12 Organization, and East Asian Government and Politics; and;
- 13 **WHEREAS**, in addition to educating our students in the various aspects
- of political science, Dr. Matheny has provided leadership and guidance to the
- 15 University community serving as the Coordinator of the Political Science
- 16 Program, an Undeclared Majors Advisor, the UOG Centennial Fund Director,
- 17 as a member of many faculty committees, and as an Advisor to the University
- 18 of Guam Student Government Association; now therefore, be it
- 19 **RESOLVED,** that the Executive Committee of I Mina' Bente Nuebi Na
- 20 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the
- 21 people of Guam, recognize and commend Dr. Richard Regan Matheny for his
- 22 many accomplishments, his dedication to our students at the University of
- 23 Guam, and most especially for his contributions to the people of Guam; and
