Relative to Congratulating the Palauan Community and the Koror Club of Guam on the auspicious occasion of the Silver Anniversary of the Establishment of the Koror State Constitution, Republic of Palau (Belau)

BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

Whereas, the people of Palau, along with the people of Guam have long shared an ancient history spanning more than four millennia, first greeted British traders and prominent visitors in the 18th century; and

Whereas, in 1783, the English Vessel Antelope, under the command of Captain Henry Wilson, was shipwrecked on a reef off of Palau's Ulong Island, one of the Rock Islands of Koror and with the help of the Koror High Chief Ibedul, Captain Wilson and his crew were welcomed to stay and rebuild their ship which took approximately three (3) months, once repairs were completed, Chief Ibedul sent his son, Prince Lebuu, back with the sailors to be educated in England; although Lebuu died of smallpox shortly after arriving in London, his presence there touched many Britons and piqued their interest in Palau; and

Whereas, following this significant contact between Palauans and Westerners more foreign explorers sailed through Palauan waters and the islands were open to further European contact; and

1 Whereas, Germany acquired the Palauan Islands at the beginning of the 20th century and handed them over to Japan, and after the defeat of Japan in World War II 2 with the costly and historic Battle of Peleliu, which took place from September 15 -3 4 November 25, and took the lives of more than 2,000 Americans and 10,000 Japanese 5 soldiers, the United States gained control over what were then called the Marshall, 6 Caroline, and Marianas Islands; the islands became part of the United Nations' Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands with Palau administered as on of the three island groups' 7 8 six districts; and 9 Whereas, after three decades as part of the UN Trust Territory of the Pacific 10 under US administration, this westernmost cluster of the Caroline Islands opted for 11 independence in 1978 rather than join the Federated States of Micronesia; and 12 Whereas, on July 9, 1980, the Palau constitution was ratified, and its first 13 constitutional elections were held and the Island nation became known as the Republic 14 of Belau (Palau) in 1981; and Whereas, on October 21, 1983, the Koror State Constitutional Government was 15 16 established as one of the Republic's sixteen (16) Island States; and 17 Whereas, Koror or "Oreor", the largest city in Palau, is where seventy (70) 18 percent of the republic's population lives and is the city that hosts most annual festivities and special events for the island nation and was the site of the capital from 19 20 Independence, in 1994 to 2006, when Melekeok became the new capital; and 21 Whereas, the State of Koror has three bridges that connects Malakal Island, 22 Ngerkebesang Island and Babeldaob, and remains Palau's economic hub and 23 commercial center - the country's main city that hosts the location of most national 24 government offices, hospital, high schools, college, churches, hotels, ports and various

business establishments; and

Whereas, a vast array of Palauans who had lived in Koror brought their culture of hard work and respects for family and traditions to Guam, their home away from home; and

Whereas, on October 25th, 2008 the Palauan community will celebrate the 25th Koror State Constitution Day, a day that commemorates the establishment of their statehood, which was chartered on October 21, 1983; and

Whereas, this occasion of the 25th anniversary of the Koror State Constitution provides a wonderful opportunity to recognize and celebrate the rich cultures if the Palauan community who have enhanced our Island community; and

Whereas, the members of the Koror Club are proud to be a strong supporter of the Palauan Community Association of Guam and the general island community by contributing to various educational, sports and community charities over the past several years; and

Whereas, the members of the Palauan community have continued to enrich our proud tradition of diversity and endow our island of Guam with their unique and collective strength; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina Bente Na Liheslaturan Guåhan*, does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam commend the Koror Club of Guam and the people of the Republic of Palau (Belau) on the occasion of their 25th Koror State Constitution Day celebrations and further extend a sincere Un Dangkulo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse to all our fellow Palauans on Guam for the positive contributions that they have made for the betterment of our island community; and, be it further

Resolved, that the Speaker certify to and the Secretary of the Legislature attest the adoption hereof and that copies of the same be transmitted to the Honorable Tommy Remengesau, Jr., President of the Republic of Palau; the Honorable Yoshitaka
