
I MINA BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE Resolution No. 252

Relative to commending the Principal, Teachers and Students of Kanagawa Prefectural Ohara High School in Japan for their visit to Guam to pay respects to the Victims of World War II on Guam, and to thank the U.S. Explore & Study Inc. for their work on the project.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I MINA BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, a group of about 250 high school students and advisors from Japan visited Guam for the purpose of showing respect and prayer for those who died during World War II; and

WHEREAS, those students visited World War II related sites on Guam, including the War in the Pacific National Historical Park overlook on Nimitz Hill and the Manengon Memorial Site in the village of Yona, in order to pay tribute and give a

prayer for those who died at these and other sites on Guam; and

1 WHEREAS, this visit and show of respect by students from Japan to visit sites of 2 World War II battles; and 3 WHEREAS, it is hoped that this will become an annual trip, and that tribute made 4 by these high school students shine as an example that will encourage other 5 students and organizations from Japan to make similar trips; and 6 WHEREAS, U.S. Explore & Study, Inc. has been instrumental in trying to heal the 7 wounds of World War II and tensions over the war between the people of Japan, 8 Guam and the United States, and has held ceremonies and tributes in the past years 9 with that noble aim; and 10 WHEREAS, the U.S. Explore & Study, Inc., along with its president, Mr. Ken Haga, 11 have worked extremely hard to move towards these goals and especially to help 12 organize this trip by Japanese High School students; now, therefore be it 13 **RESOLVED**, that I Mina 'Bente Nuebi na Liheslaturan Guåhan on behalf of the people 14 of Guam does hereby highly commend and thank the principal, teachers and these 15 High School students of Japan for visiting Guam and the World War II sites, and 16 honoring those who died at those sites, with their prayer and tribute; and be it 17 further 18 RESOLVED, that I Mina 'Bente Nuebi na Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby show its 19 U.S. Explore & Study, Inc. and Mr. Ken Haga for their efforts in arranging this trip 20 and for continuing efforts to heal the wounds of World War II; and be it further 21 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Secretary of the Legislature attest to, 22 the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to the 23 principal and students of Kanagawa Prefectural Ohara High School in Japan; to Mr. 24 Ken Haga; and, to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, I Magalahen Guatian.
