Relative to Recognizing Mr. Emelio Uy for celebrating the culture of the Philippines and Filipino entrepreneurship here on Guam and to commend him on celebrating his 58<sup>th</sup> Birthday with wishes of more to come.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I  
2 MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Emelio Uy was born on November 11, 1950 in Manila,  
4 Philippines to proud parents Lino H. Uy and Yong So Ching; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Emelio Uy attended St. Stephen's High School in the  
6 Binondo District of Manila, Philippines from start to finish of his grade school  
7 years. Mr. Emelio Uy then earned his Bachelor of Science in Commerce from  
8 the University of Santo Tomas in 1971; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Emelio Uy arrived on Guam in November 1981 and  
10 started his business, National Office Supply in January 1982 as Vice-President  
11 and General Manager; and,

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Emelio Uy has been an active member of Guam's  
13 community as evidenced by a list of accomplishments and commendations  
14 from various civic, professional and government organizations, most notably

1 the Lions Club International where he served as the District Governor for  
2 District 204 from 1996 to 1997. He continues to serve as the Extension  
3 Chairman for the Lions Club District 204. He is also currently a member of  
4 the Board of Directors for the Guam Museum Foundation and a member of  
5 the Board of Advisers for the University of Santo Tomas Alumni Association  
6 of Guam; a two-term President of the Filipino Community of Guam from 1998  
7 and again in 2001 to 2002; and a former member of the Board of Directors for  
8 the American Red Cross; and,

9       **WHEREAS**, Mr. Emelio Uy has received numerous awards and  
10 recognition from Guam and the Philippines such as the Banaag Award, the  
11 Presidential Award of the Philippines from President Fidel Ramos given to  
12 him 1996; The Golden Scroll Award from the Young Achievers Foundation in  
13 March 1994; a Certificate of Recognition from the Secretary of Foreign Affairs  
14 of the Philippines Raul Manglapuz in 1990; Guam's Most Distinguished  
15 Volunteer Award from First Lady Roseanne Ada in 1990; The Golden Latte  
16 Award from the Guam Visitors Bureau in 2006, a Commendation from the  
17 University of Guam Intercollegiate Athletic Council in 2006, an Outstanding  
18 Achievement Award in 1992 and 1995 from the Consul General of the  
19 Philippines and the Magalahi Award for the Arts from the Governor of Guam  
20 in 1994 and 1995; now, therefore, be it

22 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the  
23 people of Guam, recognize and commend Mr. Emelio Uy, Businessman,
