6 Romouldo, Maria Christina, Norman James, Oneta Louise, Patrick Arthur and  
7 Quinina Elizabeth at their residence in Tumon Heights; and

8           **WHEREAS**, Arturo was employed as a Parts Manager for Allen Sekt  
9 Motors and Lillian was a staffing specialist at the Consolidated Industrial  
10 Relations Office (CIRO) before they relocated to Subic Naval Base in the  
11 Philippines on contract; and

13 of Personnel Services, CCPO Naval Station - Treasure Island, in San  
14 Francisco, California on April 30, 1989; and
