WHEREAS, Colonel Walter, in 1994, was first assigned to the National Guard Bureau serving in many capacities until he was re-assigned to the Pentagon in 2001 as a strategic planner for the Deputy Chief of Staff of the Army for Operations, and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2002, Colonel Walter was designated as the Chief of the Army National Guard Environmental Program Division supporting all facets of the Construction and

Facilities Management Office - Environmental Programs Division - Compliance, Conservation,
 Pollution Prevention and Restoration; and

WHEREAS, Colonel Walter's insight provided the foundation to develop the capabilities and management of the technical, administrative and military staff; and

WHEREAS, it is through the support of Colonel Walter that the staff and management on Guam developed and further improved the operations, and long range planning for the Guam Army National Guard Environmental Program Division; and
