




1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE**
2 **OF I MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:**

3 **WHEREAS,** On November 17, 2003, The Consulate General of the
4 Philippines was pleased to welcome to Mrs. Teresita Mendiola as she
5 assumed the responsibility of Consul General; and

6 **WHEREAS,** Consul General Mendiola is the wife of Mr.
7 Sinforiano C. Mendiola and the proud mother of Susanne; and

8 **WHEREAS,** she completed her education at the University of the
9 Philippines earning a Bachelors and Masters Degree in Business
10 Administration; and

11 **WHEREAS,** Consul General Mendiola brought to her post on
12 Guam extensive experience in foreign affairs. She began her career as a
13 Certified Public Accountant with the Department of Foreign Affairs

1 (DFA) of the Republic of the Philippines and upon successfully
2 completing a qualifying exam, became a Foreign Service Officer in 1986;
3 and

4 **WHEREAS**, her service with the Department of Foreign Affairs,
5 Republic of the Philippines, guided her through a journey filled with
6 extraordinary experiences. From 1986 – 2002, Consul General Mendiola
7 took the reigns of a number of responsibilities that included Executive
8 Director of the Office of Protocol and Director of the Visa Division (2000
9 – 2002), Director of the Socials Division of Protocol (1991 – 1994), Special
10 Assistant at the Office of the Coordinator (1987 – 1993), and
11 simultaneously served as Acting Director at the Gulf Division of the
12 Office of the Middle East and African Affairs; and

13 **WHEREAS**, she continued to broaden her portfolio by
14 participating in a number of international conferences including a
15 Conference on the International Counter Terrorism in Tel-Aviv, a
16 meeting on Nuclear Weapons Disarmament in Mexico in 1998, and the
17 Intelsat Communications Meeting, also held in Mexico in 1997; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Prior to her relocation to Guam, Consul General
19 Mendiola had a one year stint at the Philippine Embassy in Tel Aviv,
20 Israel as Minister and Consul General. Her previous postings were at
21 the Philippine Embassies in The Hague as Finance Officer, in London as

1 Administrative Officer and in Mexico as First Secretary and Consul
2 General; now, therefore, be it

3 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Nuebi*
4 *Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam,
5 express our heartfelt appreciation, *un dangkolo na si Yu'us Ma'ase*, and
6 recognize and commend The Honorable Teresita L. Mendiola, Consul
7 General of the Republic of the Philippines for her exemplary service to
8 Guam during her posting to the island; and be it further

9 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Secretary of *I Mina'bente*
10 *Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* attest to the adoption hereof, and that
11 copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to the Honorable Teresita L.
12 Mendiola, Consul General to Guam of the Republic of the Philippines;
13 the Honorable Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo, President of the Republic of
14 the Philippines; and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahren*
15 *Guåhan* (Governor of Guam).
