


**MINA BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN**

- 1           **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Patricia Palomo was born on February 10, 1956,  
2 to Carlos Cruz Guerrero (dec.) and Julia Castro Guerrero, *Familian Anako*  
3 and *Tico*, on Guam; and
- 4           **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Patricia Palomo entered her "New Life" after a  
5 sudden illness on May 21, 2007. She is survived by her mother Julia  
6 Castro Guerrero, *Familian Tenbat and Chala*; her three sons Gregory  
7 Gerard Palomo, Gerard Christian Palomo and JeCarlo Gerard Palomo  
8 and her husband Greg G. Palomo; and
- 9           **WHEREAS**, after graduating from the Academy of Our Lady of  
10 Guam in 1974, Mrs. Patricia Palomo continued her studies at the  
11 University of Guam and earned her Bachelor's Degree in Education from

1 the University of Guam with a Certificate in Professional II Elementary  
2 K-5; and

3       **WHEREAS**, from August 1980 to her death, Mrs. Patricia Palomo  
4 was a dedicated Teacher for Grades Three, Four and Five at C.L. Taitano  
5 Elementary School where she also had many accomplishments and  
6 activities throughout the years, some of which she started. These  
7 included teaching during Summer School, DEED Teacher, DEED Co-  
8 Coordinator, Parent Teacher Organization Treasurer, the Awards  
9 Committee and the End of the Year Committee. She was also the Sports  
10 Co-Coordinator for baseball and kickball, for the Junior Police Cadet and  
11 for the Fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) Grade Promotional Awards and Banquet. She printed  
12 the first C.L. Taitano Elementary T-Shirts, hats, pencils and most  
13 recently, pins; and

14       **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Patricia Palomo was also involved at St. Jude  
15 Church in Sinajana as a lay person in her capacity as a Lector, a member  
16 of the Christian Mothers Association and a *Techa*; and

17       **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Patricia Palomo will be greatly missed by her  
18 family and colleagues at C.L. Taitano Elementary School, for her cheerful  
19 smile, beautiful personality, boisterous greetings, her daily zest for life  
20 and love for all children. She has left her footprint in the hearts of  
21 students past and present. A tree is to be planted in her honor at the  
22 grounds of C.L. Taitano Elementary School; now therefore, be it
