WHEREAS, the late Ruben D. Basilio, M.D. was born on September 13, 1936 and
 called to rest on Sunday, June 3, 2007 at the age of 70; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Basilio's legacy will live on in the hearts and memories of his loving
wife Lourdes Cruz Basilio, their children, spouses and family: his daughter, Rita Mae and
husband Andrew Chan and grandchildren Nicholas and Elena; his son David and wife
Lori and grandson Anthony; his son Nino and wife Christi and granddaughters, Marissa
and Hannah; and youngest daughter Beata and husband William Triplett; and

8 WHEREAS, Dr. Basilio earned his Doctor of Medicine Degree from the University 9 of St. Tomas, College of Medicine and Surgery, Manila, Philippines in 1961, and shortly 10 thereafter, passed the Philippine Medical Board. The young doctor conducted his 11 Residency in Internal Medicine at the Veterans Memorial Hospital in Quezon City, PI from 12 1961-1963; and WHEREAS, Dr. Basilio Interned at Coney Island Hospital, Brooklyn, New York,
 New York from 1963-1964 and conducted his Residency in Internal Medicine at Brooklyn
 Veterans Affairs Hospital, Brooklyn, NY, NY from 1964 -1967. In 1968 he was appointed as
 a Fellow in the Renal and Electrolyte Section (Nephrology) at the Brooklyn VA Hospital,
 and in Gastro-Enterology at the Brookdale Hospital and Medical Center, State University of
 New York, College of Medicine; and

WHEREAS, in 1970, Dr. Basilio returned to his roots after he accepted an
appointment as Chief of Nephrology at the Veterans Memorial Hospital in Quezon City,
PI, and pioneered the First (1st) Dialysis Unit while he served as the Medical Director of the
institution, In 1972, Dr. Basilio was the Nephrololgist for the team who conducted the
inaugural Renal transplant in the Philippines; and

WHEREAS, in 1974, Ruben D. Basilio, M.D. brought his expertise and his family to
the island of Guam at the invitation and under the sponsorship of the late Honorable
Senator Ernesto M. Espaldon, M.D., F.A.C.S; and

WHEREAS, within a year of his relocation to the island, Dr. Basilio established the
First (1st) Dialysis Unit on Guam and served as the Hemodialysis Medical Director at the
Guam Memorial Hospital; and

WHEREAS, in 1975, Dr. Ruben Basilio partnered with Dr. Benjamin Sison and
 opened the first of his private practices on Guam, the ITC Clinic, located at the
 International Trade Center in Tamuning; and

WHEREAS, in 1981, Dr. Basilio was the Medical Director of the first Health
 Maintenance Organization for the island - Doing Business As: the Guam Memorial Health
 Plan; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Basilio expanded his care for the convenience of the island
 community as the founder of the former Pacific Dialysis Corporation in Dededo, the Guam
 Renal Care, in Hagatna, the Guam Dialysis Center in Tamuning and most recently, through

a partnership with Dr. Saied Safa, M.D.; the Pacific Medical Group which was opened in
 2005 and offers a full range of Medicinal practices; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Basilio's vision and foresight has contributed greatly to the island
community, he maintained his steadfast commitment to improving the quality of life and
health of the people of Guam through his efforts and work; and

6 WHEREAS, Dr. Basilio was an engaged member of the community, a member of the
7 Guam Medical Society, and an advisor to the Guam Renal Organization, he enjoyed the
8 fullness of life, and tennis, and was an avid fan of the San Antonio Spurs of NBA fame; and

9 WHEREAS, Dr. Basilio's healing hands and quiet strength touched the hearts of all 10 who had the privilege of knowing him, known as a loving and supportive husband and 11 father, a generous and constant friend, "Dr. B" is held as a selfless and dedicated doctor by 12 his patients and an esteemed and respected physician by his colleagues, whose nurses and 13 staff viewed him as their strongest supporter and champion. He has improved the lives of 14 many in our community; now therefore be it
