Footnotes: Bill 30-177 is seeking to allow the Office of the Attorney General to charge a fee for its "AG's clearances". The fee is to be pegged on the cost of a police clearance or court clearance, whichever is higher. A police clearance and a court clearance is \$7.00 and \$15.00 respectively. An estimate of 500 AG clearances are requested in a fiscal year. The Office of the Attorney General can collect approximately \$7, 500. (500x\$15) for the fiscal year. The fees collected are to be deposited into a new special fund, "Victim/Witness Travel-Housing Fund". The funds will be used to offset the travel and housing costs of victims living off-island who must return to testify in criminal trials. These costs are currently being charged to the Attorney General's General Operations account. A19
