The proposed legislation seeks to establish an Academic Travel Fund to allow students at any public or private school on Guam to attend off-island academic events. To fund this proposed special fund, the sum of \$100,000 is authorized to be appropriated from the Healthy Futures Fund annually effective October 1, 2011 and each year thereafter. In addition other forms of financing such as gifts, devises, bequests, donations and all other kinds of contributions are authorized through the University of Guam. This institution has been designated the authorized administrator for this proposed program.

Based on the effective operation date of this proposed travel fund, it is estimated that the available funding for the Healthy Futures Fund at September 30, 2011 is \$405,303, more or less, provided the projected revenues are tracking accordingly to meet the Healthy Futures Fund projection of \$20,297,556 for FY 2011. Given this funding scenario, there should be sufficient funding to meet the fund requirement of \$100,000 for October 1, 2011, provided additional appropriations do not exceed \$300,000 in FY 2011.
