^{1/} Section 4 of the proposed legislation authorizes I Maga' Lahen Guåhan to transfer up to Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) from any unencumbered appropriations of the General Fund or Healthy Futures Fund to cover the cost of the feasibility study on providing afterhour urgent cares services in the public health centers. There may be a potential fiscal impact for additional funding requirements as the actual cost of the feasibility study is not determined at this time.
