Per information received from the Guam Election Commission, one of the fiscal impacts would result from the proposal to increase the rate of compensation for Precinct Officials from \$170 to \$350. The estimated impact for 290 (5 Precinct Officials x 58 Precincts) Precinct Officials is \$101,500. As for the other fiscal impacts, the Bureau is unable to quantify the amounts at this time.
