Footnotes:
1/ Under the proposed legislation, a fine of \$100 per day is assessed for violations under the zoning law, which are to be deposited into the proposed Zone Enforcement Fund. An estimated 100 violations not rectified per year, totals \$3.6 M. And this does not include other evident violations which go unreported, given the insufficient number of inspectors and the limited scheduling periods. Information from the Department of Public Work, Building Permits Section reflects an addition of four (4) building inspector positions are needed to carry out the provisions as stipulated, at an estimated cost of \$147,281 per year, which may be offset by fines collected under the proposed legislation.
