<sup>1/</sup> The Bill has a potential impact on the financial condition of the Government of Guam in terms of a decrease in real property inventory as a result of the proposed land exchange. In addition, the government property is 1,049± square meters more than the private property being exchanged for the use of Guam Waterworks Authority. However, in the present form of the Bill, that impact cannot be determined at this time. Please refer to DLM's findings and recommendations covered by their memorandum dated June 7, 2012 attached.
