Footnotes:

According to the Guam Department of Education (GDOE), of the \$60.08M deposited into the Adequate Education Act Trust Account, approximately \$38.1M is unabligated as of August 15, 2012. Efforts are underway by GDOE to obligate additional contracts on or before the deadline of September 30, 2012 - established by P.L. 31-40 and as currently required by the U.S. Department of Education (USDOE). However, it is highly unlikely that the entire unabligated amount will be encumbered by 9/30/2012. For this reason, on July 19, 2012, Governor Calvo submitted a request to USDOE for the same extension period proferred by the subject Bill. See attachment for details. Please be advised that a formal decision has not been rendered by USDOE as of this date.
