Footnotes:

1/ The Bill has a potential fiscal impact that may prove to be positive in the availability and utilization of Government of Guam local funds. The Bill which proposes to create the Mayors' Council of Guam (MCOG) Revolving Fund will be an additional funding source for MCOG to fund programs, projects and special events. Because of its ability to generate revenues for deposit into the revolving fund, MCOG may be less dependent on local GovGuam funds for their annual operation. Therefore, annual local funds earmarked for MCOG may be reduced and such reduced funds may be reallocated to other GovGuam agency program needs. However, in its present form, such impact cannot be determined at this time.
