The intent of Bill 538-31 (COR) is to authorize the Guam Economic Development Authority to sell revenue bonds of not more than \$20 million dollars to finance the construction and development of 200 units for a new affordable housing project titled, "Ironwood Lada Senior Village". The revenue bonds will be payable solely from revenues derived from the project and will not be an indebtness of GEDA or the Government of Guam. Total estimated interest for the bond is over \$35 million dollars based on the terms listed. The bill amends PL 30-172 to include "for profit organizations" to be allowed to purchase the property. The bill also amends Public Law 31-195 which specifically notes the lot numbers of the properties the project will be constructed on. There will be no fiscal impact on the General Fund with the passage of
