Footnotes:

Bill 539-31 (COR) provides for a tax credit to Maeda Pacific Corporation on adjudicated claims per Civil Case No. 0135-04 against the Government of Guam. The Government was ordered to pay an amount of \$2,915,000. The intent of the bill is to authorize a tax credit in order to avoid a cash payment by the Government due to its financial condition. The bill also authorizes the option of utilizing the tax credit for a five (5) year period. The passage of this bill will enable the Government of Guam to comply in making payments on its obligation. It is beneficial to the Government as it may alleviate the financial impact to only one given year if the company extends its tax credit over the 5 five year period.
