1/ The proposed legislation seeks to create a Task Force on the 'Guam Product Seal' Program which shall be under the direction of the Office of the Lt. Governor who shall also serve as the Chairperson. The Task Force shall provide policy direction and recommendations relative to coordination, planning, administration, implementation and enforcement of the program. In its current form, it may have an impact as the provisions indicate administrative functions of the Program and to develop funding, continuity plan and a budgetary proposal. However, such costs cannot be determined absent information on the extent of such administrative support (i.e. personnel,
