Footnote

At its present form, the proposed legislation will fiscally impact specific departments such as Guam Fire Department (GFD), Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA), and Department of Puble Health & Social Services (DPHSS) in the implementations of programs identified in this legislative bill. Some of these programs such as the added responsibilities for the Emergency Medical Services Administration and the Emergency Medical Service Commission at DPHSS, GFD, and GMHA would contribute to increased operational costs that have not been included in the FY 2012 Budget Act. Such increased operational costs at this time cannot be determined in order to assess the fiscal impact to the participants of these programs.
