**COMMENTS TO BILL 06-32(COR)**

BILL NO. 06-32 IS AN ACT TO AMEND §25.15 AND §25.20 OF CHAPTER 25, TITLE 9, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO STRENGTHENING PENALTIES FOR CRIMES INVOLVING CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT, WHICH MAY BE CITED AS THE "*PREDATOR PREVENTION ACT*".

Although the Bill does not mention about increases in any fines, it does, however, propose to increase "jail time" to life imprisonment without parole for a first Degree Criminal Sexual Conduct. In addition to that, it proposes that "terms shall not be suspended nor probation be imposed in lieu of said term nor shall parole, work release or educational programs outside the confines of prison be granted." These could entail fiscal impact(s) to the Unified Courts and the Department of Correction's operations to insure that the Bill, if passed into Public Law, is fully implemented.
