The Bureau requests that Bill No. <u>102-32(COR)</u> be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 102-32(COR) is an Act to amend §4402 of Ch. 4, Title 4, GCA relative to meetings of the Civil Service Commission to include the provisions of deliberations. The amendment notes that CSC meetings will still be an open forum to the public *except* that any and all deliberations of the board may occur in a closed session with no requirement of transcription/recording of such deliberation. Deliberations can only be conducted in the presence of the Commission's Board Members, Legal Counsel, and Executive Director.

The intent of the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.

I MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN 2013 (First) Regular Session

B.J.F. Cruz

AN ACT TO AMEND §4402 OF CHAPTER 4, TITLE 4, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE MEETINGS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section §4402 of Chapter 4 of Title 4, Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

"§4402.Quorom and Deliberations

The quorum of the Commission shall be four (4) members. Meetings of the Commission shall be conducted in accordance with the Open Government Law except that any and all deliberations of the Commission may occur in a closed session and no transcript of such deliberation need be maintained, nor shall the Commission be required to record such deliberation. When conducting such closed deliberations, only members of the Commission board, along with the Commission's counsel and its Executive Director may be present. No action may be taken by the Commission during such closed deliberation and voting must occur in open session. The affirmative vote of four (4) members shall be required for any action of the Commission and such vote must be conducted in an open, public meeting. The Commission may adopt rules to govern its procedures and the standards maintained by non-attorney representatives; provided, that

rules adopted by the Commission shall recognize that representative is not an attorney and cannot be bound by the same standards and ethics as an attorney; and, further, provided, that in cases where an employee represents oneself, the Commission shall render all possible assistance to the employee to insure a fair and impartial hearing."
