Attachment to Fiscal Note No. 103-32 (COR)

The proposed legislation is aimed at amending the current law regarding stipend payments for meeting served by board members of boards and commissions. Section 14 of Public Law 31-233 states that if a board member has served on a board continuously for ten (10) years or more, they may receive stipends totaling no more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250) per month for meetings attended.

The Civil Service Commission currently has seven (7) board members receiving stipends at Fifty Dollars (\$50) per meeting. Out of the seven (7) board members, three (3) members have served for more than ten (10) years and receive stipends amounting to five (5) meetings per month (\$250 monthly stipend cap ÷ \$50 per meeting attended). CSC meetings are held twice every week, with a conditional third meeting depending on the severity of the case at hand (about 8-12 meetings per month).

If the proposed legislation is passed, the members who have served on the CSC board *will not be* subject to the Two Hundred Fifty (\$250) monthly stipend caps. The Bureau estimates that an additional \$150-\$350 per month/\$1,800-\$4,200 per year will be required for CSC to cover stipends for the three (3) board members who have served continuously for ten (10) or more years. There is sufficient funding this fiscal year to cover the projected stipends for the three (3) board commissioners.

12       Service Commission, any Board member who has served on a Board  
13       continuously for ten (10) years or more may receive a stipend totaling no  
14       more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250) per month for meetings  
15       attended; however, Board and Commission members may elect to not  
16       receive said compensation, I Maga'låhen Guåhan may by Executive Order,  
17       waive the payment of meeting stipends owed to any Board or Commission  
18       member.”
