Comments:

1/ The intent of this Bill is to add a new Section 16 to Chapter X (Guam Visitors Bureau) of Public Law 31-233 which will appropriate a total of \$25,000 from the Tourist Attraction Fund to the Huråo Academy, Inc. for the purposes of continuing their mission to promote and perpetuate the Chamoru language and culture.

The Huråo Academy, Inc. is a non-profit organization that was created in an effort to address the need for a "stable" and "successful" Chamoru language program on Guam. The Huråo Academy, Inc. is the first "fullimmersion" Chamoru language program to meet the needs of a community struggling to preserve their language, and to promote and perpetuate the Chamoru language and culture for the past, present, and future generations of children through the implementation of immersion community programs, the development of educational materials, and any other related areas that support this mission.

Based on the FY2012 released audit by the Office of Public Accountability for the Tourist Attraction Fund (TAF) for FY2012, the Fund Balance amount is \$4,065,015, but which is committed for tourist related operations in accordance with § 30107 of 11 GCA. The current status of the TAF revenues reflect as tracking positively in FY2013.

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 16 TO CHAPTER X OF **PUBLIC LAW 31-233 (GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT OF** 2013) MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE TOURIST ATTRACTION FUND (TAF) TO HURAO ACADEMY, INC. TO PROMOTING AND MISSION IN THEIR CONTINUE LANGUAGE AND THE **CHAMORU** PERPETUATING CULTURE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the Chamoru language and culture has been and is under immediate threat of extinction, and that the only "proficient" speakers of the Chamoru language are now 50 years and older. Furthermore, with the average life expectancy of Guam's Chamoru people at 65-70 years, it is conceivable that the language will be extinct by 2025.

8 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that the Huråo Academy, Inc. 9 established in 2005, is a non-profit organization that was created in an effort to 10 address the need for a "stable" and "successful" Chamoru language program on 11 Guam. Additionally, Hurao Academy, Inc. is the first "full-immersion" Chamoru 12 language program to meet the needs of a community struggling to preserve their 13 language. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that the Huråo Academy has grown its language immersion program serving over 4,000 students. Furthermore, the Huråo Academy also added parent, adult and corporate class programs serving over 2,000 students, parents, and adults in the community-at-large and have begun cultural apprenticeship classes in blacksmithing and weaving, providing translation services, ChagiChamoru, a television language program and a cultural preservation program.

8 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that revenue estimates for the Tourist 9 Attraction Fund (TAF) for Fiscal Year 2013 are tracking at Twenty-Five Million 10 Five Hundred Ninety-Six Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars 11 (**\$25,596,688**), of which Twenty-Three Million Eight Hundred Eighty-Eighty 12 Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (**\$23,888,200**) is appropriated.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the TAF revenues for Fiscal Year 2013 are projected to exceed appropriations by One Million Seven Hundred Eight Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars (**\$1,708,488**), *in addition to* the Fiscal Year 2012 ending cumulative fund balance of Four Million Sixty-Five Thousand Fifteen Dollars (**\$4,065,015**), and is available for appropriation.

18 I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the Huråo Academy, Inc. has been 19 the only organization on Guam who has consistently provided Chamoru Language 20 Immersion programs to the community since 2005, and in the effort to increase the 21 number of native language speakers on Guam, it is the intent of I Liheslaturan 22 Guåhan to support the Hurao Academy, Inc. to continue their mission to promote and perpetuate the Chamoru language and culture for the past, present, and future 23 24 generations of children through the implementation of immersion community 25 programs, the development of educational materials, and any other related areas 26 that support this mission.

Section 2. A New Section 16 is hereby added to Chapter X (Guam
 Visitors Bureau) of Public Law 31-233 to read:

3 "Section 16. Appropriation to Hurao Academy, Inc. The sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) is hereby appropriated 4 from the Tourist Attraction Fund (TAF) to Hurao Academy, Inc. for the 5 purposes of continuing their mission to promote and perpetuate the Chamoru 6 7 language and culture. Notwithstanding the general provisions of §30107.1 8 of Chapter 30, Title 11 GCA, and this Act, this appropriation shall continue 9 to be available until expended. The provisions contained in Section 14 (Service and Reporting Requirements) of Chapter X of Public Law 31-233 10 11 shall be applicable."

Section 3. Effective Date. The provisions contained herein shall take
effect immediately upon the enactment of this Act.
