## Footnotes:

1/ The proposed legislation seeks to include a ban on the sale of 'candy cigarettes'. Although the measure is administrative in nature, there is a fine not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) imposed for any person found guilty of the importation or attempted importation of tobacco film strips, tobacco sticks, tobacco hard candles, nicotine lollipops, nicotine lip balms, nicotine water and candy cigarettes. Thus, a potential fiscal impact can range anywhere from \$25,000 (for a single distributor) to \$250,000 (for ten distributors) found quilty of such importation.
