

COMMENTS ON BILL NO. 121-32 (LS)**

Should the proposed legislation become law, the sum of seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000) from \$5 million in uncollected tax refunds escheated to the General Fund at the end of FY2012 and available for appropriation in FY2013, to the Department of Administration for the acquisition of software, migration, fiber connection security, and other upgrades necessary to support and protect the Government of Guam's computer system and network infrastructure. According to Department of Administration, funds are available however, an estimated amount cannot be determined at this time due to the nature of the escheated account being funded by unclaimed tax refunds, and the total number of unclaimed tax refunds cannot be determined until after September 30, 2013. It should be noted that funds being appropriated through this bill must be expended within one (1) year following the date of enactment, any funds remaining will no longer be available to the Department of Administration and shall become available for future appropriations by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.

2 Section 1. Appropriation. Notwithstanding any other provision of
3 law, the sum of Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) escheated

6 **Section 2. Unused Appropriation.** Funds not expended pursuant to

11 **Section 3. Reporting Requirement.** The Director of the Department
