BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. **Removal of Slot Machines in definition of Gaming Devices.** Sub-item "(1)" of subsection "(n)" pertaining to the definition of Gaming 3 Device, of §7102, Chapter 7, Title 3, of the Guam Administrative Rules and 4 Regulations is hereby deleted, to read as follows: 5 "(n) "Gaming device" 6 means any equipment mechanical, or

electromechanical or electronic contrivance, component or machine used remotely
or directly in connection with gaming or any game which affects the result of a
wager by determining win or loss. The term includes:

10 (1) A slot machine."

11 Section 2. Effective Date.

12 The provisions contained herein shall be effective upon enactment of
