Comments:

1/ The intent of this bill is to amend Section 2 (c) of Public Law 25-55 relative to 911 Surcharges, "deleting the maximum twenty five (25) access lines for telephone service and deleting the maximum twenty five (25) account numbers per account bill rendered per month for commerical mobil radio service". Based on "The Guam Public Utilities Commission E-911 Fiscal 2012 Surcharge Summary- GTA Docket 12-05 dated December 27, 2012 prepared by Slater, Nakamura & Co LLC consulting firm, the total number of lines (postpaid and prepaid) by Fiscal Year Ended September 30, 2012 is 2,078,903 of which 121,919 are noted as lines exempted from \$1.00 surcharge with a total net lines of 1,956,984. Should this bill become law, there will be a potential increase in revenue of at least \$121,919 based on the number of exempt lines reported as all lines and account numbers reported by the Collection Agents (Docomo Pacific, GTA Telecom, Guam Telecom, I-Connect, Pacific Data System, PTI Pacifica dba IT&E, Pulse Mobile) will be charged \$1.00 per month for 911 Surcharge.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

3 **Section 1.** Section 2 (c) of Public Law 25-55 is amended to read as follows"

5 "(c) The "911 Surcharge" shall be established by the Commission at a rate *not* to
6 exceed One Dollar (\$1.00) per month per access line, ~~up to a maximum of twenty-~~
7 ~~five (25) access lines per account bill rendered for local exchange~~ telephone
8 service, and at a rate *not* to exceed One Dollar (\$1.00) per month per ~~account~~ line
9 number for commercial mobile radio service, ~~up to a maximum of twenty-five (25)~~
10 ~~account numbers per account bill rendered per month.~~ "

12 **Section 2.** The Compiler of Laws shall codify the provision of Public Law 25-55
13 inclusive of the amendments made by Section 1 of this Act.
