Bueñas Yan Hafa Adai: Submitted for your review are comments on Bill Number 017-32 - An Act to Allow For Conditional Use of Property Situated in the Municipality of Dededo for Meetings and Cultural Purposes, Specifically Lots 15-3 and 15-R3, Both of Tract 1413, Which Are Currently Zoned "A" (Agricultural), Containing an Area of 4,208.7 Square Meters, and Bordered By Alageta Road. We provide the following comments:

- Deliberation on such matters typically fall under the requirements of Title 21, Guarn Code Annotated, Chapter 61, Zoning Law, Article 3, Use Regulations, §61303, under the regulatory auspice of the Guam Land Use Commission.
- 2. This section under the zoning law allows specific uses provided certain qualifying standards of assessment are achieved relative to:
 - a. An assessment of potential impacts to elements that affect the immediate community to include disposal of sewage, egress/ingress, parking, structure location and dimensions of buildings, impact of the proposed use on adjacent land uses;
 - b. Considerations of other elements as reasonably related to the persistence and encouragement of protecting the health, safety and general welfare of the immediate community; and
 - c. Public input particularly from adjacent property owners and immediate community¹

Bill No. 17-32 unfortunately does not provide such information to support for appropriate assessment, let alone agency concurrence with its intent.

We recommend that in the event parties of interest wishes to continue pursuing legislative consideration of this request that *at a minimum*, supporting information as aforementioned be provided to allow further more appropriate assessment. Otherwise, such parties are encouraged to follow the typical process of submitted a Conditional Permit Application to the Guam Land Use Commission. Through this process, two critical actions will prevail:

- An attempt to gain public input through certified public notice, particularly to adjacent and immediate property owners most affected by the conditional use; and
- 2. An attempt to gain certified assessment by appropriate government agencies dealing with infrastructure.
