#### Footnotes

The intent of Bill 21-32 (COR) is to amend Section 66104.2 of Chapter 66, Title 10 by providing for the following amendments: 1) reduce the number of service hours from 2080 hours to 500 hours in order to increase number of eligible candidates; and 2) eliminate participation of program candidates in the government of Guam's health insurance program. With the amendment in eliminating health insurance coverage, the government of Guam will save approximately \$4,100 per employee.
