1/ According to the Office of Technology under the Department of Administration, a cost estimate to implement web-based platforms have not yet been prepared nor a timeline determined to prepare one. However, the proposed bill provides the Chief Technology Officer to determine the cost and report findings to the *1 Liheslaturan Guahan*. In order to provide a cost estimate and based on queries and information gathered on web-based development, specifically web-based, meeting/conferencing and/or communication services, the estimated project cost for large companies could range from \$100,000 to \$1,000,000 depending on hardware and software requirements and number of participants.

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT THE OFFICE OF TECHNOLOGY ESTABLISH A WEB-BASED MEETING PROTOCOL TO ALLOW AGENCIES TO HOLD NON-PUBLIC MEETINGS REMOTELY BY *ADDING* A *NEW* SUBSECTION (k) TO §20204.1 OF ARTICLE 2, CHAPTER 20, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Short Title. This Act *shall* be referred to as the "Responsible
3 Web-Based Meetings Act".

4 Section 2. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds 5 that each agency of the government of Guam holds meetings for management and 6 staff. Many agencies are not located within a single building, so when such meetings are organized, all participating employees must go to a single location. 7 8 Many private organizations regularly utilize online meeting platforms to allow for 9 the participation in meetings at remote locations. The use of web-based meeting 10 platforms for intra-agency and inter-agency meetings can significantly reduce the amount of productive hours lost for employees in transit from their jobsite to the 11 location of meetings. 12

13 It is therefore the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to require the Chief 14 Technology Officer to adopt a web-based meeting protocol for use by agencies of 15 the government of Guam for the secure web-based meetings, by adding a new

subsection (k) to §20204.1 of Article 2, Chapter 20, Title 5, Guam Code
 Annotated.

3 Section 3. Secure Web-Based Meeting Protocol Required. A new
4 subsection (k) to §20204.1 of Article 2, Chapter 20, Title 5, Guam Code
5 Annotated, is hereby *added*, to read:

6 "(k) The Chief Technology Officer *shall* adopt standard protocols for use by 7 agencies of the government of Guam to establish secure web-based platforms for 8 non-public meetings of government of Guam employees within ninety (90) days 9 from the enactment of this Act. The Chief Technology Officer shall determine the 10 cost of implementation of secure web-based platforms for non-public meetings on 11 a per agency basis and report such findings to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to further 12 determine financial feasibility of implementation."
