#### Footnotes:

According to information received from the Executive Director of the Guam Election Commission, this would apply to a vacancy of 240 days or more prior to the date of the next general election which would be applicable to a vacancy occuring before or by March of 2016. Next, the Executive Director continued to explain that the cost impact would vary depending on the village the vacancy occured. For example, if a Mayoral vacancy occured in the village of Agana Heights, there is only 2 precincts. Thus, the cost involved would be less compared to the village of Dededo that has 13 precincts. The fiscal impact would result primarily from the number of ballots required to be printed, supplies and staff required to conduct the Special Election. Finally, it was mentioned that for this Special Election, the ballot counting equipment will <u>not</u> be used. Instead, all ballots will be hand counted. This could minimize the overall cost impact.

#### **1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

- 2 Section 1. "TITLE 3 GCA § 13106. Events Causing Vacancy in the

There shall be no primary election. Candidates 7 8 must file their candidacies no later than thirty (30) days prior to the 9 special election date. The highest vote-getter (or vote-getters if there 10 is more than one [1] vacancy), shall be certified by the Guam Election 11 Commission as elected and shall be administered the oath of office 12 immediately to fill the unexpired vacancy. If both Mayor and Vice 13 Mayor offices are vacant, resulting in a special election for two [2] 14 vacancies, the highest vote-getter shall become the Mayor-Elect, and 15 the second highest shall become the Vice Mayor-Elect." 16 Section 3. Section 6105 (b) of Title 3 Guam Code Annotated

#### "§ 6105. Person Eligible for Only One (1) Office.

(a) No person shall be eligible for more than one (1) elective office tobe filled in the same election. The term "election" as used in this Section

includes a general and a local election held on the same date, so as to

 election at the same time.

(b) No person shall be eligible for an office to be filled in an election if
sixty (60) days prior to the primary he or she is holding another elective
