Footnotes: 1/ The intent of the proposed legislation is that Route 15 be named and designated 'Air Force Highway.' A fiscal impact is anticipated in the posting of highway signs to read 'Air Force Highway' and in the conduct of a dedication ceremony, as specified in the bill language. The Department of Public Works (DPW) has provided a total unfunded estimate of \$2,600 comprised of \$1,600 for the production of signs with parts and \$1,000 for the dedication ceremony, the fund source of which is not identified per the bill language; and as such may have to be absorbed by DPW. Also, \$1,537 is the estimated cost that will have to be absorbed by DPW in terms of manpower requirements for 6 equipment operators estimated at \$857 (or \$17.85 per hour for 8 hours), and equipment use (i.e. bucket truck) of \$680 (or \$85 per hour for 8 hours) in the installation of the signs. Comments on Bill No. 27-32 (COR)

The bill's intent is that Route 15 be named and designated 'Air Force Highway' to honor our servicemen and women of the United States Air Force, our United States Air Force veterans, and the United States Air Force in general, as they have played a vital role in securing our region from the Second World War onwards and continue to serve the cause of liberty throughout the world.

Section 2 *adds* a new § 850 to Title 1, Guam Code Annotated relative to designation of Route 15 as 'Air Force Highway.' The mandate specified requires that the Department of Public Works (DPW) post 'Air Force Highway' signs along the current Route 15, at appropriate intervals, and at prominent overhead locations at the intersection with 26-Macheche Road, Dededo; at the intersection with Route 10, Mangilao; and at reasonable intervals visibly designating Route 15 as 'Air Force Highway.' Also stated is that a dedication ceremony is to be held no later than one hundred and twenty (120) days after the enactment of this Act.

The Department of Public Works (DPW) has provided a total *unfunded* estimate of \$2,600 comprised of \$1,600 for the production of signs with parts (i.e. perforated posts, nuts and bolts, 2-color reflective sheeting, sheet metals, readymix cement, etc.) and \$1,000 for the dedication ceremony (i.e. refreshments of \$500 and tent/chair rentals, if not available at the mayor's office at \$500), the fund source of which are not identified per the bill language, and as such may have to be absorbed by DPW.

Also, \$1,537 is the estimated cost that will have to be absorbed by DPW in terms of manpower requirements for 6 equipment operators estimated at \$857 (or \$17.85 per hour for 8 hours), and equipment use (i.e. bucket truck) of \$680 (or \$85 per hour for 8 hours) in the installation of the signs.



BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds 2 3 that many sons and daughters of Guam have honorably served our community and 4 country through the United States Air Force, and have protected our island and national interests often at the cost of their lives. The proud men and women of 5 Guam who have served the United States Air Force have represented our island's 6 7 pivotal position in the Pacific, as manifested by Andersen Air Force Base, which 8 has played a vital role in securing our region from the Second World War onwards 9 and continues to serve the cause of liberty throughout the world. For these reasons, 10 I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds it fitting that Route 15 be named and designated "Air Force Highway" to honor our many existing United States Air Force servicemen 11 and women, our United States Air Force veterans, and the United States Air Force 12 13 in general.

Section 2. A new §850 is hereby *added* to Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, to
 read as follows:

"§850. Designation of Route 15 as 'Air Force Highway.'

(a) Route 15 is hereby designated as 'Air Force Highway.'

(b) The Department of Public Works shall post, along Air Force 5 6 Highway (currently Route 15), at appropriate intervals, signs that visibly identify the highway's official name. The Department of Public Works shall 7 8 place said signs in prominent overhead locations at the intersection with 26-9 Macheche Road, Dededo; at the intersection with Route 10, Mangilao; and 10 at reasonable intervals visibly designating Route 15 as 'Air Force Highway.' 11 The Department shall further display signage along the roadside dedicating 12 'Air Force Highway' to our men and women serving in the United States Air 13 Force, our United States Air Force veterans, and our men and women in the 14 United States Air Force who have lost their lives while in service to their island and country. A dedication ceremony for the designation of Route 15 15 as 'Air Force Highway' shall be conducted no later than one hundred and 16 twenty (120) days after the effective date of this Act." 17
