The Bureau requests that Bill No. 292-32 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 231-32(COR) is an Act to add a *new* subsection §4104.2 of Chapter 4, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated relative to the proof of eligibility for Veterans Preference Credit.

The Bill proposes that persons claiming veteran's status must submit their DD Form 214, Armed Forces of the United States Report of Transfer or Discharge. The Bill stipulates that in order for a person to receive veteran's preference, they must have accumulated at least 180 days of service in the Armed Forces of the United States without receiving a dishonorable discharge.

The intent of the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new subsection §4104.2 is hereby added to §4104 of

Chapter 4, Title 4 of Guam Code Annotated to read:

"4104.2 Proof of Eligibility for Veteran's Preference

Credit. Persons claiming veteran's status must submit their DD

Form 214, Armed Forces of the United States Report of Transfer or

Discharge. A person must have completed at least 180 cumulative

days of service in the Armed Forces of the United States and must

have received other than a dishonorable discharge from such

service to be eligible for veteran's preference."

Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall become immediately effective upon enactment.

Section 3. Severability. If any of the provisions of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall *not* affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
