AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE OFFICE OF VETERANS AFFAIRS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE GUAM VETERANS REGISTRY AS MANDATED IN PUBLIC LAW 32-101.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.

I Liheslaturan Guahan finds that Public Law 32-101 recognizes the Office 3 of Veterans Affairs as the official local agency for establishing and maintaining the 4 Guam Veterans Registry(Registry); which shall be updated no less than 5 semiannually. The information obtained from the registry will help to strengthen 6 7 our application as we work to secure future funding from the federal government 8 for our island veterans. Additionally, the registry would be used to provide current 9 information on health care, on home-based care, the very best programs, benefits and services possible. 10

Our veterans are approaching us with more specific needs than the past: increasing personnel, ensuring access to resources by building on existing programs, establishing and maintaining a Guam Veterans Registry is the right thing to do to provide the highest level of care. Additionally, in order to continue providing claim forms preparation as a free service to our local veterans through the Veterans Affairs Office, representatives are required to be an accredited claims

agent. Accreditation means the authority granted by VA to representatives, agents,
and attorneys to assist claimants in the preparation, presentation, and prosecution
of claims for VA benefits. 38 C.F.R. § 14.627(a). Without accreditation, an
individual may not independently assist claimants in the preparation, presentation,
and prosecution of claims for VA benefits. *I Liheslatura* clearly understands this
and has appropriated within FY 2014 Budget \$619,000 to the Office of Veterans
Affairs, a significant increase from the FY 2013 Budget of \$322,000.

I Liheslaturan Guahan further finds that based on *I Maga'lahi Guåhan*'s transmittal letter to the Honorable Speaker on December 16, 2013, regarding the need for sufficient appropriations to comply with Public Law 32-101; *I Maga'lahi Guåhan* requested of the *I Liheslatura* to follow-up by providing the Office of Veterans Affairs with the means necessary to carry out the obligations imposed upon it by this new law.

I Liheslatura further finds that the total estimated windfall of new withholding taxes for retroactive and prospective law enforcement salary adjustments is Three Million Nine Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$3,940,000). Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslatura* to provide additional funding to the Office of Veterans Affairs from the estimated windfall of new withholding taxes from retroactive and prospective law enforcement salary adjustment revenues for the purpose stated herein.

Section 2. Implementation of the Guam Veterans Registry.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of Veterans Affairs for the implementation of the Guam Veterans Registry as mandated in Public Law 32-101; and *shall* include but not limited to the following:

26 1) To hire Two (2) additional personnel under the following position title
27 and salaries in accordance with Department of Administration:

(A) Clerk I 1 Clerk Typist I; and 2 **(B)** To purchase materials, supplies and office equipment to implement 3 2) and sustain the Guam Veterans Registry; and 4 3) Implementation within Ninety (90) days of enactment. 5 Said funds shall not be subject to any transfer authority of I Maga 'lahen Guahan. 6 Said funds *shall* continue to be available until fully expended for the purpose stated 7 8 herein.

9 Section 3. Severability. If any provisions of this Act or the application 10 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not 11 affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect 12 without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 13 Act are severable.
